TRASH: Collected every week year round. Must be curbside by 7am on your day in containers (weight limit 50 lbs). No wood or construction material (take wood materials to CMCMUA, may require a fee).

COURTESY BULK: Residents are allowed (2) free items per calendar year. Ex. Sofa, Bureau, call for an appointment.

RECYCLABLES: CANS AND BOTTLES 1-7, SEPARATE PAPER Collected every week on your trash day YEAR ROUND.

HOLIDAY: ○ indicates Holidays. Trash will be collected the next working day. Recyclables will be collected the following week on your regular trash day. **EXCEPTION: December 25, trash and recyclables will be collected December 26th.**

BULK : METAL ONLY □ indicates Metal pick-up EXAMPLE stove, refrigerator, air conditioners and bikes. **(NO WOOD, FURNITURE etc.) A scheduled appointment is necessary, call Public Works Department 609-884-0898**

BATTERIES: Single use batteries can be placed in trash.

WHAT TO RECYCLE: Aluminum Cans, Steel (tin) Cans, Glass Bottles, Jars & Jugs, Plastic Bottles, Jars and Jugs with symbols 1 through 7.

HOW TO RECYCLE: Empty containers and remove lids. Place together in one reusable container

VEHICLE STICKERS

- PROOF OF LOWER TOWNSHIP RESIDENCY IS REQUIRED TO GET A STICKER
- ONE (1) STICKER PER HOUSEHOLD
- STICKERS MUST BE AFFIXED ON DRIVER SIDE BUMPER OR INSIDE ON REARVIEW MIRROR FACING TOWARDS THE FRONT WINDSHIELD

WITHOUT STICKER YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO USE FACILITY

RECYCLING CENTER ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

HOUSEHOLD TRASH (INCLUDING STYROFOAM, POOL COVERS, VACUUM CLEANERS.
RIGID PLASTICS/ LARGE PLASTIC TOYS, LAUNDRY BASKETS, LAWN FURNITURE
BOTTLES / GLASS / PLASTIC (#1 through #7 PLASTIC, GLASS BOTTLES AND TIN CANS)
PAPER / CARDBOARD BOXES
METAL (MISC. METAL, B-Q GRILLS, METAL POLES WITHOUT CONCRETE)
APPLIANCES (FREEZER & REFRIGERATOR DOORS MUST BE OFF)
AIR CONDITIONERS
EMPTIED LAWNMOWERS
GRASS CLIPPINGS
BRANCHES (7' IN LENGTH & 6" IN DIAMETER OR LESS)
LEAVES (MUST BE BAGGED OR COVERED WITH A TARP)

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

HAZARDOUS WASTE (PAINT, GAS, KEROSENE, ANTI-FREEZE, ETC.)
TIRES
BUILDING MATERIAL (SHINGLES, LUMBER, SHEETROCK, PANELING, WOOD PALLETS
WINDOWS, DOORS, GARAGE DOORS, ETC.)
RAILROAD TIES AND LANDSCAPING TIES
BULK ITEMS (FURNITURE, MATTRESS/BX SPRING, PICNIC TABLES, ETC.)
CONCRETE, BRICKS & CINDERBLOCKS
STUMPS (LARGER THEN 3" IN DIAMETER)
CARPETING, RUGS & PADDING
PROPANE TANKS
(NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS ARE ACCEPTED AT THE CMCMUA TRANSFER)
