Inaugural Escape the Cape Triathlon SOLD OUT on June 2, 2013

Road Closures and Detour information for local residents and businesses

On June 2, 2013 The Inaugural Escape the Cape Triathlon will take place at the Cape May-Lewes Ferry Terminal in Lower Township, NJ. There will be 3 events taking place simultaneously; a 'sprint' triathlon consisting of a .35 mile swim, 10 mile bike, and 5k run. The 'international' triathlon consists of a 1 mile swim, 20 mile bike, and 5 mile run. And, an International Aquabike consisting of a 1 mile swim, 20 mile bike only. All 1000 athletes will begin the event by leaping from the Twin Capes Ferry into the Delaware Bay and swimming to shore. For the cycling and running portions of the event, there will be road closures and detours. On June 2, 2013 between 7am and 11am, All persons living along Ferry Road, Johnathan Hoffman Blvd, the West Cape May Bridge, New England Road, Batts Road, Atlantic Ave, and Beach Drive can expect road closures during this time. Attached is a map of the entire course from start to finish. If you live along this route, please use caution and have a plan to take an alternate route the morning of June 2.
